Privacy Policy

Data Controllers

The Data Controllers (hereinafter the Controllers) are:

- Institute of Cognitive Science and Technology –National Research Council of Italy
- the Association “Pratiche Dialogiche Italia – APS.”

Controllers act as joint controllers under a co-ownership agreement pursuant to Article 26 of the GDPR. The agreement identifies the role of each controller in data processing.

Data Processor

Within the meaning of Article 28 of the GDPR, PayPal is designed as Data Processor.

As a European bank registered in Luxembourg, PayPal complies with data protection and financial regulatory requirements.

Types of Data collected

In order to complete the membership association to “Pratiche Dialogiche Italia – APS”, the Controllers collect the following Personal Data:

- name, surname, city, country, date of birth, place of birth, email.

The Data Processor may collect the Personal Data according to their [Privacy Statement](#).

Methods of processing

The Controllers take appropriate security measures to prevent unauthorized access, disclosure, modification, or unauthorized destruction of the Data.

The Data processing is carried out using computers and/or IT enabled tools, following organizational procedures and modes strictly related to the purposes indicated. In addition to the Controllers, in some cases, the Data may be accessible to external parties (such as third-party technical service providers, mail carriers, hosting providers) appointed, if necessary, as Data Processors by the Controllers.

Legal basis of processing

The Controllers may process Personal Data once the Users have given their consent for the following purposes:

- completing the membership association to “Pratiche Dialogiche Italia – APS;”
- participating in the 27th International Network Meeting for the Treatment of Psychosis
- receiving the certificate of attendance to the 27th International Network Meeting for the Treatment of Psychosis.

Users can withdraw their consent at any time.

Moreover, the provision of Data is necessary for the performance of an agreement with the User (i.e., the membership association to “Pratiche Dialogiche Italia – APS” for one year).

Retention time

Personal Data shall be processed and stored for as long as required by the purpose they have been collected for. Therefore:

- Personal Data collected for the purposes of administering the Users’ attendance to the 27th International Network Meeting for the Treatment of Psychosis and issuing the certificate of attendance to the Meeting shall be retained as long as needed to fulfill such purposes (i.e., until the 30th of September 2023).
- Personal Data collected for purposes related to the membership association to “Pratiche Dialogiche Italia – APS” shall be retained until such contract has been fully performed (i.e., for one year).

Once the retention period expires, Personal Data will be deleted. Therefore, the right of access, the right to erasure, the right to rectification and the right to data portability cannot be enforced after expiration of the retention period.

The purposes of processing

The Data concerning the User is collected to allow the Controllers to provide the Services (i.e., provide the association membership to the User, register the User to the conference and share communications about the event with the User), receive payment in consideration of the Services being provided, comply with its legal obligations, respond to enforcement requests, protect its rights and interests (or those of its Users or third parties).

The rights of Users

Users may exercise certain rights regarding their Data processed by the Controllers.

- **Withdraw their consent at any time.** Users have the right to withdraw consent where they have previously given their consent to the processing of their Personal Data.
- **Object to processing of their Data.** Users have the right to object to the processing of their Data if the processing is carried out on a legal basis other than consent.
- **Access their Data.** Users have the right to learn if Data is being processed by the Controllers, obtain disclosure regarding certain aspects of the processing and obtain a copy of the Data undergoing processing.
- **Verify and seek rectification.** Users have the right to verify the accuracy of their Data and ask for it to be updated or corrected.
- **Restrict the processing of their Data.** Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to restrict the processing of their Data. In this case, the Controller will not process their Data for any purpose other than storing it.

- **Have their Personal Data deleted or otherwise removed.** Users have the right, under certain circumstances, to obtain the erasure of their Data from the Controller.
- **Receive their Data and have it transferred to another controller.** Users have the right to receive their Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, if technically feasible, to have it transmitted to another controller without any hindrance. This provision is applicable provided that the Data is processed by automated means and that the processing is based on the User's consent, on a contract which the User is part of or on pre-contractual obligations thereof.
- **Lodge a complaint.** Users have the right to bring a claim before their competent data protection authority.
